Where is Slovak's First mega-scale battery factory located?

Located in the Slovak city of Šurany, the facility commenced construction on October 28 local time. Slovak Prime Minister Robert Fico and Gotion chairman Li Zhen attended a groundbreaking ceremony, according to a statement released today. The project marks Slovakia's first-ever mega-scale battery factory, spanning 65 hectares.

What's going on with FICO's new battery plant in Slovakia?

Fico said that the plant represents one of the largest investment projects in Slovakia's history, marking the beginning of a new era for the automotive industry. Gotion announced on Decem, plans to invest a total of €2.514 billion (\$2.91 billion) to build battery production bases in Slovakia and Morocco.

Who owns INOBAT batteries in Slovakia?

The Slovakian facility will be developed by Gotion InoBat Batteries (GIB) EnergyX Slovakia, a joint venture where Gotion holds an 80 percent stake and local battery company InoBat Auto jsa holds the remaining 20 percent. Gotion acquired a 25 percent stake in InoBat in September 2023.

How much will the Morocco battery plant cost?

The planned total investment for the yet-to-break-ground Morocco battery plant would not exceed €1.28 billion, with an annual capacity also set at 20 GWh. The Morocco project would be constructed by Gotion Power Morocco, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Gotion, located in the Rabat region of Morocco.
