Tashkent, Uzbekistan, — The World Bank Group, Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company PJSC (Masdar), and the Government of Uzbekistan have signed a financial package to fund a 250-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic plant with a 63-MW battery energy storage system (BESS).

The plot of land designated for the development of the PV plant facilities, including the collector sub-station is under the ownership of the Joint Stock Company (JSC) Uzsuvtaminot, which is a utility company providing water supply and sewerage services within Tashkent Region.

Who will sell electricity to in Uzbekistan?

The project company is committed to selling electricity to the state-owned National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan JSC under a 25-year Power Purchase Agreement for the project, including a 10-year operating term for the BESS component, signed by these two entities.

Where is Bess project located in Tashkent?
